Requirements for the Postdoctoral Fellowship Application March 2026 – February 2027

<u>Please refer to the Rules of Operation of the Postdoctoral Scholarship Program at UNAM 2025,</u> to verify the specifications of any of them. *

Candidates must have been awarded a doctorate from any prestigious institution at most five years before the initial date of the post-doctoral program, and they must evidence their productivity with a published work, or a work approved for publication in any internationally renowned specialized journal.

- 1. Opinion of the advisor about the academic background of the candidate and the project to be developed.
- 2. Copy of the doctoral degree diploma, the certificate of approval of the doctoral examination or official document indicating the date of presentation of the doctoral examination. *
- 3. Summary of the doctoral thesis with the name of the person who advised the work and their affiliation.
- 4. Updated Curriculum Vitae.
- 5. Research project to be developed (include Activity Schedule), endorsed by the advisor.*
- 6. Letter signed by the candidate and endorsed by the advisor, in which he explicitly commits himself to dedicate himself full-time exclusively to the approved research project and program and to comply with the obligations established in the University Legislation and in the Rules of Operation of the Postdoctoral Scholarship Program at UNAM. (Commitment letter)

- 8. Curriculum synthesis of the advisor. *
- 9. Copy of the advisor's degree.
- 10. Copy of the advisor's most recently approved annual report.
- 11. Application form.
- 12. Copy of an official identification document (passport or professional ID).
- 13. Published works.
- 14. In case of having foreign nationality, and if the scholarship is approved, prove your legal stay in the country or expressly express your commitment to carry out the procedures required to have the accreditation.
- 15. 2 (two) letterhead recommendation letters addressed to the Consejo Interno del Centro de Ciencias Matemáticas.
